Monday, October 11, 2004 this locomotive was removed from its long time home at the Placer County Fairgrounds to a new location in downtown Roseville. This “Ten-wheeler” was built in 1897 by Cooke Locomotive. It was converted to fire train use in 1929 and used on the Donner Pass route for grass, brush, and snow-shed fires. Retired from SP service in 1956.
